Last year hundreds of local people took part in our survey to say what they want to see happen to the St Ann's site. The top priority was for **homes** that local people can afford to rent or buy, closely followed by **health services**, **green spaces** and **community facilities**.

The results also show overwhelming support for the idea that local people are best placed to say what's needed and to take a lead in the site's redevelopment and management.

Based on these results and the ideas developed in three consultation meetings, our team of architects have come up with the next set of draft plans that we would like to share and discuss with you.
